5. Tell about the family and how it impacted your person's life.
6. What is your occupation? Explain what you do.
7. Why are you important?
8. Tell us TWO important things that happened in your life.
9. Tell us about some of your accomplishments.
10. How have you affected our lives?

You should practice your presentation in front of your family before our Living History Day. You may use your poster to guide you. Try not to read it, just use it to cue your speech! Part of your grade will be on your public speaking skills (eye contact and loud voice.)
