Curriculum Update-

Language Arts: We have been working on reading and looking for the main idea, central message, and details. We have been working on our grammar: continuing to look at sentence structure, subjects, predicates, verb tense, subject/verb agreement, and also facts and opinions.

In Writing, we have been sorting details into subsections of our writing. We all did a sort about Sharks. Students are now working on their own Information pieces.

Math: We have been learning strategies for finding an unknown factor and for multiplying with multiples of 10. I am seeing the fact recall of students improve and this has helped as we have moved into seeing the relationship between multiplication and division. We will move into Division after the holidays.

Social Studies: We have been finishing up our California Regions booklets and have now moved into our Native American Unit, talking about the Ohlone Native American group that are from our area. This will tie into our Deer Hollow Farm Field Trip.

Deer Hollow Farm:

Bring a backpack, draw string bag, or bag that allows students to have their hands free to explore within the area. Students will be carrying their own lunches (trash free, please), water bottles, layered clothing, and perhaps a hat for the sun.
