Curriculum update:

Reading: We started our Character Studies unit. Readers are getting to know new characters in their book in the same way that they get to know a new friend, noticing how the character talks and acts. Once they have gotten to know a new character, they study their character and think, "What kind of person is this?"

Writing: In Writing, we have looked at what characters say and do in books and come up with ideas about them. We will write summaries of text and continue to pull evidence from reading. We will work at lifting exact lines and quoting and eventually move into short literary essays.

Math: During the next few weeks, our math class will be learning more about fractions. We will learn how to compare fractions, order fractions, and find equivalent fractions.

Social Studies: We have started to read various biographies. We have learned about Milton Hershey and today, in celebration of National Potato Chip Day, we learned about George Crum.
