

Oral Presentation Topic: Museum Display

These are the directions for Museum Display about a scientific or social studies topic.

1. Read a scientific or social studies nonfiction book about a topic that interests you. This book must be at least 50 pages long, but does not have to be a chapter book. Get your book checked with your teacher Thursday, April 25th, 2024.

2. Make a three-dimensional (3D) display for our class museum walk activity, using information you learned from your book.

- This display may be made like a triorama, a shoebox scene, or any other way you decide to have it be three-dimensional (not a poster).
- Make sure your display is your own creation and not a store-bought kit.
- Be sure all parts are attached well so that your display stays together.
- Make sure it can sit independently on a desk without you having to hold it.
- Make sure you put details and effort into your display.
- Please include the name of the book, the author of the book, and the designer of the display (that's you!) on your display.

3. Create notecards with bullets to use notes during your speech presentation.

4. Please bring your display to school between Wednesday, May 15th and Thursday, May 16th. Please do not bring your presentation early, or it will be sent home. There is not enough room in our class to store everyone's display. All presentations will be given on Thursday.
