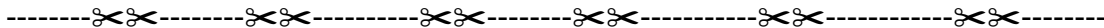


# MYSTERY BOOK REPORT

**Due: Friday November 15, 2024**

1. Choose a **mystery book** to read. It should be at least 75 pages long. Fill out the bottom portion of this paper with your parent and return it to school by **Friday, October 25<sup>th</sup>**.
2. Read the book.
3. Fill out “**A Mystery Solved!**” paper in your **best writing**. Make sure you check for misspellings and grammar mistakes. (Have an adult check it over for you). Attach it inside a file folder, and decorate the outside of the file folder to make it look like an “official” detective’s file.
4. Using the paper provided by me, make a poster to advertise your book. Be sure to include the book, title, author, and tell what the mystery is in your poster (e.g., Who stole the diamond ring?).
5. Prepare a short presentation (2-3 minutes) advertising your book. Tell us enough to get us interested in reading the book **without** telling us the whole story. You should tell your audience the title, author, and what the mystery is. **Do not tell us how the mystery is solved.**
6. Practice your presentation at home and be ready to present it **Friday, November 15<sup>th</sup>**.
