Curriculum Update:

Reading- Readers will be practicing envisioning a scene from their reading, by acting out a part from our read alouds and drawing a picture of a scene they thought the author was asking them to envision. We will practice lifting the level of their reading and recruiting partners to support them.

Writing- Room 16 writers have been working on stretching out the heart of their story and on using details to help the reader understand the story's shift.

Math- Mathematicians learned to break apart numbers as a strategy to addition. We continue to look at numbers in different ways (standard, expanded, word forms) and have been subtracting using place value and the background understanding for how to regroup. Also, we will be covering a little more about interpreting and representing data via bar graphs, line plots, tables, and picture graphs.

Social Studies: We are still continuing to work on our Geography Unit and are now creating individual maps of our community.
